Guest Speaker: Kath McIntyre SA Film Corporation

Kath is a film maker and producer. She has been in the industry for 16 years and made documentaries and commercials.

She was involved with McLeods Daughters – which was a wonderful experience although hard work, with great producers and cast. The series bought \$70m to the state over 6-7 years.

Kath has been involved in many Award winning films and worked with numerous stars.

She started in camera department then assistant director then documentaries. Long days with work starting at 5 or 6 am to 7pm & usually 6 day weeks.

She is now in Film Service Management, and sells the State to the world to bring films to SA. There are approx 20-30 features a years & 6 per year made in SA

SA Film Corp invests into film using new talent, new directors and interesting films. SA does not depend on off shore productions like other states, but uses the uniqueness of our state.

The film industry is very much a relationship building industry. Our unique locations like the Flinders Ranges is in high demand for both commercials and films such as Holy Smoke, Rabbit Proof Fence plus many more. Adelaide is also sold as an Urban environment because of the size of the city, low costs (producers want more for less) easy transportation and access. We also have good crews who have up to 3

or more years experience so they know what is needed and are a strong asset

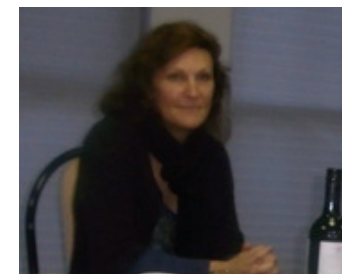
The Film Corp has a Professional Development arm which trains the next generation and also has Peer to Peer training for Filmmakers.

The Film Corp has a role as a supporting agency by investing into films, providing training and content/scripts and works with the industry and in the development of script for feature film and documentaries.

They are also involved in Digital media content and gaming (future industry). Changes in audience behaviours have made the move in this direction.

The corporation provides some funding in conjunction with the government to support in Production, acts as a sales agent, acts as a distribution agent, advice on incentives, post production facility f or sound mix.

The Corporation has strategic partnerships with SA Tourism, and is known as a flexible and dynamic agency. Who do a great job going out to the world to sell our state as the place to be.
